# Topícs:

#### **Beginner Brewing**

Matt briefly described the experience that he and Jackie Kendall recently had with the "brew on premise" process at Flying Barrel in Frederick. This approach offers some definite benefits for a novice. Many recipes are available (with all ingredients), since this is also a homebrew supply store. There are staff members available for guidance, although you do most of the work yourself (*e.g.* sparging the grain). There is better equipment (e.g. large kettle, floor drains, efficient wort chiller) than many new brewers would have on hand. Our process had two stages: We brewed on one day (2-3 hours total time), then we'll return in a few weeks to bottle the beer and take it home. The total cost for a 5-gallon batch (2+ cases) is comparable to retail pricing for the style we chose, and it's a good learning experience. Something to consider!



### Beer Tasting for Points 101

Kevin led an introduction to beer tasting as a judge would do it. This is timely because the selection of club entries for the ICC (see item below) is based on matching a specific style, as compared to "Wow that tastes good!". He used Harpoon IPA as an example to show us how the key areas of **Appearance**, **Aroma**, and **Taste** are evaluated on an overall 50-point scale, using a detailed scoring sheet. A second practice session, using homebrew products, is planned for the March club meeting.
